



Parque Histórico de Guayaquil

The Parque Histórico de Guayaquil (Historical Park) will transport you back in time to the end of the XIX Century. You will take a look at the province of Guayaquil as it once was; it is divided into three sections covering a total of 10 acres.

The Wildlife Section: This area is surrounded by mangrove forest and from here you will enjoy a walk through the wooden trails and you will also have the opportunity to observe different animals of coastal and jungle areas that were once part of Guayaquil.

Urban Architectural Area: Home to wooden houses and buildings that were part of Guayaquil at the beginning of XX Century as well as its transportation system, customs & fashion.

Traditional Zone: The countryside; experience the simple but relaxing life of local farmers, their animals, plantations and houses during one of the most prosperous times of the cacao boom.
