



## **EL Morro**

### **Dolphins and Birds at El Morro**

El Morro port is located 70 miles from Guayaquil, this is a salt water inlet from the Pacific Ocean, and the brackish water is the perfect habitat for several species of birds and dolphins that feed on fish in the shallow water.

The drive to El Morro port takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes from Guayaquil. Upon arrival at the port you will board a motor boat, during the navigation you will observe aquatic birds such as brown pelican, little blue heron, snowy heron, great egret, neo tropic cormorant, roseate spoonbill among others, dolphins will show up any time at the channel or the open sea.

You will visit an islet where you will find a colony of magnificent frigate birds and other species of birds. After lunch we will return to Guayaquil.
