



Shore & forest birds

This area covers four ecosystems and more than 7 sites between Mar Bravo, Salinas & Montañita beach as well as Chongon-Colonche forest.

Day 1: 07:00 am departure from Guayaquil to Montañita Beach to visit the first site of Pacoa salt pools. The dikes here will provide you with the opportunity to observe many different species of birds in a large numbers.

After lunch you will continue driving north, passing through several fishing villages. Upon arrival at your hotel in Montañita village you will have time to observe forest birds, watch the sunset and enjoy dinner.

Day 2: Today will be an early wake-up for birdwatching at another site in Chongon Forest. After breakfast you will then drive to another site according to what your naturalist guide selects for that day (see options below).
